PD Days & Field Trips


- We have been known to throw theme parties or potlucks and may ask families to bring a dish or item for the group.
- From time to time TOPP KIDS may have special guests visit for educational purposes (eg: the Reptile Guy, Chef Chris, Police Officers, MAD Science, etc.) If you are interested in volunteering as a presenter, please talk to the Program Coordinator.
- Transportation for any trips will be provided for TOPP KIDS by an insured chartered transportation company.
- All children who plan on attending field trips must be on site minimum 1 hour before scheduled field trip departure.
- Families will be **sent a link** to sign up for PD Days to confirm attendance. **Failure to sign up by the closure date** will result in forfeiting your space and Full Time participants will not be prorated for missed days. PD Days are charged separately for Part Time and Drop In families.
- Children MUST BE DRESSED APPROPRIATELY for each trip. Failure to bring appropriate clothing will result in the child staying at the centre with the on-site team.



On The First Day...

We like to make sure we meet every family that participates in our program face to face. We ask that you come in with your child and see our program, take a tour and meet the team.

- Come in through the main school doors and proceed to the gymnasium or designated classroom and sign your child in. We open at 7am. All children will be walked to their doors at the bell. After school kindergarten and grade one children will be picked up from their classrooms and brought to the program. PICK-UPS WILL HAPPEN EVERYDAY UNTIL THE CHILDREN ARE COMFORTABLE WITH THE ROUTINE. (Kindergarten children are picked up year round).
- 2. Children will put their bags down and will be taken on a tour by one of the leaders.
- 3. Leaders will then go over emergency information, play some introductory games and explain how TOPP KIDS will work!
- 4. The children will then get a chance to meet each other through free play before our first team challenges and events.

Fee Schedule & Payments

Registration Fee

A \$50.00 non–refundable registration fee is required for each family registering in the OOSC or KindiClub program per year. This fee is not applied to any month's payment; it is strictly an administrative fee charged in the first month of care.

Fee Payment

Parents are required to provide post-dated cheques or a completed PAD form for the entire school year at the time of registration. Cheques must be dated for the 1st or 15th of every month. Payments for individual PD Days, Drop-Ins, or any miscellaneous charges must be made via cheque or your PAD account will be charged on the 15th of the following month.

Your child fills one of a limited number of spaces, and your space will be debited monthly whether your child is present or not. TOPP KIDS does not pro-rate fees for absences due to illness, vacation, program closure, staggered entry, or for any other reason. No credits can be given for days missed. TOPP KIDS does not accept cash payments.

Payments Made During the Month (PD Days, Drop-ins, etc.)

Payments/cheques given in during the month and charges for PD Days or drop-ins will be deposited on the 15th of the following month. Families must be sure to maintain their accounts so that NSFs do not occur.

If You are a Family Utilizing Child Care Subsidy:

All families with subsidies must provide postdated cheques or PAD approval for the difference between the currently approved subsidy allowance and the cost of their monthly fee for each month registered. Any remaining fees will be charged on the 15th of the following month after subsidy amounts are forwarded back to the program. Parents are responsible for paying any remaining fees by the 3rd Friday of that month. Deposit Policy still applies.

PAD Payments

If families choose to pay via our PAD (Pre-Authorized Debit) payment option, a charge of \$0.15 will be added to cover the processing fee per transaction. This includes monthly fees, any NSF fees or other payments made through ATB. All information collected will only be used for agreed upon fees and only shared between TOPP KIDS Accounting office and ATB.

What Cheques Should Look Like...

Here is an example of an accepted monthly cheque. The cheque should be dated either for the 1st or 15th of the month, NOT for the date the cheque is written. The type of care (Full Time, Part Time, KindiClub, etc.) should be listed in the area designated for "Option Registered For".
